## **FUNDRAISING**

## **UPPER SCHOOL REPORT**

#### **YMCA**

Nick from YMCA. We serve a lot of schools, and this group is great. Aftercare 120 kids daily plus dropins. Working on service projects (a can drive, care packages for soldiers, kids at Children's Hospital). YMCA offers aftercare subsidies for lower-income families.

Summer camp, part of camp will be here at ITS. Still working on figuring out which camps will be where. Goal is to have camps for each age group at each location. Aquatics, cooking, & rock climbing will be at Bowen. Hoping to have some sports at ITS & some at Harrison & Cardozo. Middle school after care is more club based. They've been working at Deal with middle schoolers and they're trying to get space there as well. We do get priority registration. Our after care staff will be camp counselors. Bowen is not allowed to take vouchers yet, but they're working on getting it. Financial aid is available. Calculation based on income.

Parent - We miss the activities at the Y branch. The Y is working on getting a bus so that it might be possible. Jasmine or aftercare teacher can share the weekly schedule. Nick can email it out. For trip camps, they will leave from Bowen.

Parent - Appreciate black history month learning that happens at the Y. Does ITS do anything like that? "It's ITS' expectation that all students are learning about all people all the time." Teachers want to make sure that these things are done in a developmentally appropriate way.
